VAN BUREN TOWNSHIP I-94 PEDESTRIAN PATHWAY NOW OPEN

Van Buren Township (December 2018) – The Van Buren Township Downtown Development Authority's (DDA) newest community advancement, the I-94 Pedestrian Bridge, has been completed and is open for usage.

Continued improvement of pedestrian and bicycle access to the business district is a priority of the Van Buren Township DDA. Located along the east side of Belleville Road, the new pedestrian overpass will improve connectivity between the north and south sides of the business district by providing Van Buren Township residents and visitors with a reliable and safe way to navigate over I-94 by foot or bicycle, connecting residential neighborhoods with the downtown area.

Working in conjunction with the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT), the Van Buren Township DDA was able to secure nearly \$500,000 through TAP grant funding to aide in the cost of construction. Landscaping and minor details will be completed during spring 2019.

The community and its Belleville Road Shopping Corridor are a convenient stop for travelers on their way to Detroit, Ann Arbor and many places in between.
