Free lunch will be provided, while supplies last.

The Law Enforcement Education Program (LEEP) will have professionals on-site to provide parents with free child ID kits containing a photograph, fingerprints, height, weight and other identifying information. These ID kits could be a great resource for police and the Amber Alert system in the event of a missing child.

Free eye exams are available for children aged 6 months to 6 years courtesy of the Lions Club KidSight Program. Designed to identify treatable and preventable causes of vision loss in preschool children, their high-tech mobile vision screener is programmed to quickly and accurately identify vision disorders through non-invasive testing.
