Stats. §19.85(1)(a) to deliberate concerning the quasi-judicial hearing regarding the Petition of Trevor Rische for an exemption to the Residence restrictions that would allow him/her to reside at 4711 N. 127th Street, Butler, WI 53007.
 - III. **Action.** At the conclusion of the closed session, if any, the Board will reconvene in open session for possible further deliberation and possible action.
