**A Resolution to Increase Recycling Charges on Utility Bills Starting in 2024**

---

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Butler currently has a charge on each 1-4 family residential property's utility bill of \$12 per unit to offset the cost of recycling services to the Village and,

**WHEREAS**, the Village has not revised this fee for several years and,

**WHEREAS**, the cost of recycling services from John's Disposal, the Village's municipal waste processor, has continued to increase and,

**WHEREAS**, the Village has certified with John's Disposal that the Village currently has 637 units of garbage and recycling collection that are billed to the Village monthly and,

**WHEREAS**, the expected cost of recycling processing for 2024 is \$32,945.64 and the Village is expected to bring in \$30,576 in recycling revenue for 2024 from those 637 units and,


**WHEREAS**, this gap in funding totals to be \$2,369.64 and,

**WHEREAS**, a \$1.00 a quarter increase, per residential unit, will eliminate this gap in funding,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Village of Butler Village Board that the recycling charge on the utility bills for 1-4 family residential properties in the Village be increased by \$1.00 a quarter per residential unit to \$13.00 per unit.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Clerk is hereby directed to post notice of these rate increases as required by law.
