

RESOLUTION NO. 24-01

**RESOLUTION TO REDUCE NUMBER OF ELECTION OFFICIALS FOR THE
APRIL 2, 2024 SPRING ELECTION AND PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE VOTE**

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statute §7.30 requires 7 inspectors for each polling place at each election, but Wisconsin Statute §7.32 allows the governing body of any municipality by resolution to reduce the number of election officials at a polling place to not less than three (3); and

WHEREAS, the voter turnout at the April 2, 2024 Spring Election is expected to be smaller, in which case, the need for election officials at the polling place will be reduced and;

WHEREAS, over the past several spring election cycles the need for seven election inspectors has tended to not been as great and;

WHEREAS, there may be 2 shifts for election workers on election days. The first shift shall commence at 6:30 a.m. and end at 1:30 p.m. The second shift shall commence at 1:30 p.m. and end with completion of all required election day duties that follow the closure of the polls.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village Board of the Village of Butler resolves to reduce the number of election officials for the April 2, 2024 Spring Election to only five (5) at a time with possible shifts for some election workers.
