 - Public Works will be delivering and picking up the picnic tables.
 - Public Works will be securing both ends of State Street for this event.Sergeant Pearse mentioned that the Police Department will be short staffed the day of the Street Dance and will need assistance with positioning people at the exits. It was the consensus of the Board that Tori reach out to her contacts for Private Security to use at the exits at \$35.00 an hour. The Village Board will need to approve a contract for these services.
- FUN RUN/WALK** - 39 people signed up to participate in this year's Fun Run/Walk. There were only 11 large shirts left out of an order of 50. The CV Men's Club provided bottled water and donuts. It was decided that we should continue to hold the Fun Run/Walk again next year.

4. **National Night Out** - National Night Out will be August 1, 2023. Sergeant Pearse stated that things are looking good. Members from the CV Masonic Lodge will be conducting the ID Project again this year. Tori will be reaching out for some food trucks (no Pizza trucks) and will be contacting the CV Library and the Valley Orchard to see if they would like participate in a Farmers Market in the Bricks parking lot. We still need someone to rewrite the Chalk Board Signs. The question was raised if we wanted to continue the sidewalk chalk again, if so, then we will need to have someone at Walnut Street assisting with the event. Dina and Tori mentioned that they have sidewalk chalk.
5. **Citizen of the Year** - Tori Schroeder and Kayla Spencer will handle the set up and cleanup. All the gifts have been purchased and refreshments have been ordered.
6. **4th of July Parade** - The Recreation Board discussed the Fourth of July Parade. Lineup will start at village Hall as early as 12:30PM with judging of the bicycles and small motorized vehicles at 12:45PM. The parade starts a 1:00PM and ends in Baumann Park. Sergeant Pearse stated that using the new parking lot at Walnut and Genoa is a better spot for a pickup location for families rather than the Tennis Courts especially for traffic. He will have the area roped off. Dina will purchase the candy for the trustees and DQ gift cards for prizes. Tori will contact Cattle and Cream for 200 tickets for participants.
