

**ORDINANCE NO. 2023 - 04**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 74, UTILITIES, ARTICLE II, WATER,  
DIVISION 4, METERS AND RATES, SECTION 74-126  
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES  
FOR THE VILLAGE OF CHERRY VALLEY, ILLINOIS**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Cherry Valley, Illinois (“Village”) has adopted a Code of Ordinances (“Code”) for the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village believes it is prudent to sustain an appropriate cash balance to provide funds for necessary infrastructure repairs and improvements within the Village Water system; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village has recently undertaken **the construction of a new well, a new well house and a water line extension project** at a significant investment to better serve its water customers; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village wishes to amend its Code provision establishing a water infrastructure charge for water services from the Village Water system; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village has determined that adopting such an ordinance is in the best interest of the Village and its citizens.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Cherry Valley, Illinois as follows:

1. Chapter 74, Article II, Division 4, Section 74-126 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows (additions shown as **bold and underlined** and deletions as ~~strikethroughs~~) (all other sections not amended shall remain as written):

Sec. 74-126. Water rates, customer charge, consumption fee, **infrastructure fee**, meter maintenance charge.

Each customer of water received from the village water system shall pay the following:

- (1) Starting May 1, 2010, forward, a monthly water service fee will be charged to customers of the village as follows:
  - a. Residential within the village: .....\$6.00
  - b. Nonresidential and commercial: .....7.00
  - c. Residential outside the village: .....8.50

- (2) A water consumption fee per 100 cubic feet consumed from July 1, 2022, through April 30, 2023, is as follows:
- a. Residential within the village: .....\$3.60
  - b. Nonresidential and commercial: .....3.60
  - c. Residential outside the village: .....3.60
- (3) A water consumption fee per 100 cubic feet consumed from May 1, 2023, through April 30, 2024, is as follows:
- a. Residential within the village: .....\$4.50
  - b. Nonresidential and commercial: .....\$4.50
  - c. Residential outside the village: .....\$4.50
- (4) A water consumption fee per 100 cubic feet consumed from May 1, 2024, through April 30, 2025, is as follows:
- a. Residential within the village: .....\$5.40
  - b. Nonresidential and commercial: .....\$5.40
  - c. Residential outside the village: .....\$5.40
- (5) A water consumption fee per 100 cubic feet consumed from May 1, 2025, through April 30, 2026, is as follows:
- a. Residential within the village: .....\$6.30
  - b. Nonresidential and commercial: .....\$6.30
  - c. Residential outside the village: .....\$6.30
- (6) A water consumption fee per 100 cubic feet consumed from May 1, 2026, through April 30, 2027, is as follows:
- a. Residential within the village: .....\$7.20
  - b. Nonresidential and commercial: .....\$7.20
  - c. Residential outside the village: .....\$7.20

**(7) Starting July 1, 2023, forward, a monthly water infrastructure fee of \$15.00 will be charged to customers of the village.**

2. Except as amended in this Ordinance, all other provisions and terms of Village Code of Ordinances shall remain in full force and effect as previously enacted except that those ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
  
3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its approval, passage, and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
