

**ORDINANCE NO. 2023-21**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CHERRY VALLEY, ILLINOIS  
AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY  
THE VILLAGE OF CHERRY VALLEY**

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE OF CHERRY VALLEY, Illinois (“Village”) has adopted a Village Code of Ordinances (“Code”); and

WHEREAS, the Village owns certain items of personal property that are used by the Village Police Department but over time, are no longer necessary or useful to, or for the best interests of the Village; and

WHEREAS, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, authorizes the Village to sell personal property, which is no longer necessary or useful to, or for the best interest of, the Village; and

WHEREAS, it is of the opinion of the corporate authorities of the Village that it is no longer necessary, or useful to, or in the best interest of the Village to retain its 2011 Chevrolet 2500 HD Utility Box Style Pick-Up Truck, VIN Number 1GB0CVGXBF170206, Model Number C20903 (the “Property”); and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to authorize the disposal of the Property by auction with Rockford Auto Auction.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Cherry Valley, Illinois as follows:

1. The above recitals are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.
2. Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Village President and Village Board of Trustees find that the Property is no longer necessary or useful to the Village and the best interest of the Village will be served by the disposal of the Property. The Village Police Chief, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to dispose of the Property by Auction with Rockford Auto Auction.
3. The Village President is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to effectuate the disposal by auction contemplated herein and the Village Clerk to attest the same.
4. Except as amended in this Ordinance, all other provisions and terms of Village Code of Ordinances shall remain in full force and effect as previously enacted except that those ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
