## Yuba City Measure D Fact Sheet

The City Council placed Measure D on the November 5th, 2024 ballot so voters in Yuba City can consider enacting a local sales tax of 1%. If voters approve Measure D, it is expected to generate approximately \$17.5 million each year in dedicated, locally controlled funds that benefit Yuba City residents and businesses.

### **BREAKDOWN OF YOUR CURRENT SALES TAX**

Tax breakdown of \$1 purchase with current 7.25% rate:

1% = YUBA CITY

6.25% = SUTTER COUNTY & STATE OF CALIFORNIA



#### LOCAL REVENUE

Currently, Yuba City's local sales tax is 7.25%, but the City only receives a small portion of the revenue generated.


